Why Some People Can't Remember Their Dreams

Do you remember your dreams? Although many people can often remember what they were dreaming about when they wake up in the morning, some rarely remember the details in their dreams — and for other people, dreams are a mystery that they can't remember at all. Now, a new study from a research team in Italy has looked into some of the factors that may affect how well we remember our dreams. The team studied 217 healthy adults between the ages of 18 and 70. These participants were asked to keep a record of their dreams and to wear a sleep monitoring device for 15 days.

The participants had to record whether they remembered having dreamed or not, what they could remember of their dream, or if they had experienced so-called “white dreams” — the sensation of having dreamed something without being able to remember what the dream was about. The participants also completed memory and attention tests as well as questionnaires to measure factors like their attitude toward dreams and their anxiety levels. The researchers did not find any significant link between age or gender and the ability to remember dreams. However, they did find that older participants were more likely to experience white dreams.

The () of the study found that there were three main factors that affected whether people could remember their dreams or not. These were their attitude towards dreams, how easily their mind wandered, and their sleep patterns. Participants who had a positive attitude toward dreams and those whose minds tended to wander when they were awake were much more likely to remember their dreams. Participants who had longer periods of light sleep with less deep sleep were also better at remembering their dreams. However, the researchers also found that the seasons affected participants' ability to remember their dreams, with dreams being harder to remember in winter than in other seasons.
